

Sultan Bin Abdulaziz Humanitarian City Award for Excellence in Rehabilitation Care 2012

The Sultan Bin Abdulaziz Award for Excellence in Rehabilitation Care will once again be awarded this year for outstanding contributions by an organization or an individual in the field of excellence in rehabilitation care.

Following on from the success of the inaugural year in 2011 we seek to expand the award this year to include international contributions.

The award this year will be split in to two categories to reward contributions by organizations and individuals both regionally and internationally.

The contributions should be in one of the following categories:

1. Implementation of Best Rehab Evidence Based Practices and Patient Centered Care Initiatives that have led to enhanced Clinical Outcomes.
2. Advancement in Research and Development of new innovative rehabilitation programs by an organization/ individual based upon best practice that has led to a measurable improvement in Clinical Outcomes.
3. Development of a new technology and inventions in rehab care provision including prosthetics and orthotics.
4. Use of technology to work better with CBR and rural or underserved areas of the country, bringing the expertise for the large metropolitan areas to the small local community.
5. Advocacy to have better opportunities/protections for people with disabilities whether that be mainstreaming into regular classrooms for kids, better physical access in the community, more people with disabilities at work etc.
